



Access to NHS Dentistry is currently limited during the pandemic as dentists have been asked to stop all routine "face-to-face" dental care.

However, if you need urgent dental care, help is at hand:



CALL your dental practice:

They will give you advice over the telephone and make arrangements for you **if you need to be seen.**

CALL 111 when it's less urgent than 999

You can ask for a translator if you need one.
NHS 111 is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
